Responsibilities:

This is for a four month position that primarily focuses on backcountry expeditions. The responsibilities of the position includes supporting trip logistics (assisting with food and gear prep), repair and maintenance of SYMG gear, trip resupplies (purchasing and repackaging food, driving resupplies to different locations, meeting groups with resupplies and helping with cooking, cleaning, etc.), assisting with potential evacuations or unforeseen needs that arise, and end of season inventory. In addition there will be opportunities to guide during the season which will be dependent on scheduling and staffing needs.

Requirements

- Twenty-one years of age
- Wilderness First Responder and CPR training is the minimum medical certification
- California Food Handler's Certificate (available and reimbursed after start date)
- Leave No Trace Awareness Training (available and reimbursed after start date)
- Valid Driver's License

Preferred

- Prior experience in trip support and logistics.
- Prior experience with a variety of backcountry gear repair
